New Member Requirements

- Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Minimum of two in school activities (clubs, Spartans sports teams, musical groups, etc.)
- Minimum of one out of school activity (jobs, church groups, scouting, community art, etc.)
- 36 hours (minimum) of community service activities (these cannot be used in the activity section)
 - Cannot use babysitting or any service that benefits family members
 - Any hours used in support of another school activity (i.e. the fundraising breakfast for the play) do not count for the 36 hour requirement.
- COMPLETE Student Information Form, including essay and signatures must be turned in by due date
- Favorable Faculty Council Rating, including a good discipline record
- Participation in the next NHS group service project

A brief look at the selection process:

Cumulative GPA's are calculated at the beginning of the second semester, and information packets are given out. (Last year, there were four weeks between passing out the packets and the due date). Faculty Rating Forms are then given out. These are collected, and both the packets and rating forms are evaluated by the Faculty Council. Letters are mailed to parents, usually sometime in April. The NHS induction ceremony is held in late May.

Why worry about this now?

Finding out the requirements early gives interested students ample amounts of time to acquire the service hours and activities needed to be inducted.

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Current Member Requirements

- Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- 36 hours (minimum) of community service activities
 - Cannot use babysitting or any service that benefits family members
 - Any hours used in support of another school activity (i.e. the fundraising breakfast for the play) do not count for the 36 hour requirement.
 - Hour logs must be completed and turned in by the due date (late March/early April)
- Continuing good conduct in school and community
- Participation in the next NHS group service project
