## February 12, 2024 Agenda Planning Meeting

- 1. The first reading of the following revised and new policies:

The Board approved a resolution to adopt a maximum building construction cost of \$28,735,630 and a maximum total project cost of \$40,058,927 for the Brentwood Borough Elementary School Project. A public hearing on such project will be held on March 7, 2024, at 7:00 pm at the Brentwood Middle High School Auditorium pursuant to and in accordance with the requirements of Act 34 and School Code.
- 3. A transportation run was ratified for one student to the Watson Institute Friendship Academy with Sun Coach Lines.
- 4. The Board approved a MOU between the Brentwood Borough School District, the BEA, and the BESPA.
- Ms. Kathryn Montogomery was hired as the long-term substitute secondary school counselor.
- 6. The Act 93 agreement was approved.

## February 26, 2024 - General Purpose Meeting

- 1. The minutes from the January 8, 2024 Agenda Planning Meeting, and the January 22, 2024 General Purpose Meeting were approved.
- 2. The Board approved the General Fund 10 Statement of Cash Receipts, Disbursements, and Cash Balances for the periods ending January 31, 2024; approved the bill payments for the period January 23, 2024 thru February 26, 2024; and approved the budget transfers for the month of February 2024.
- 3. The Board approved the exoneration of the Tax Collector from the remainder of her duplicate representing taxes, which were unable to be collected and referral of such taxes of the solicitor for collection, exoneration applies to the Tax Collector only and does not exonerate the taxpayer from payment.
- 4. The Board tabled the motion to approve the School District Financial Statements and Independent Auditor's Report for the year ending June 30, 2023 as prepared by Bielau, Tierney, Coon and Company.
- 5. The Board acknowledged receipt of the bank letters and the tax collector's summary report.
- 6. The Board accepted the bids from the Shiloh Industrial Contractors for the pool lining and deck construction, pool water heater construction, and the pool filer repairs.

- 8. The quote from Sean McGuire to remove the old auditorium lights and replace them with new lights was approved.
- 9. The Board ratified a three-year agreement with OOMA for equipment and service.

- 11. Qmlativ Transition Plan with Skyward was approved. This will be a two-step process; the student system will transition first, followed by the business financial system
