Qualifications:

- Pennsylvania certification required in Special Education Certification PK-12
- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the characteristics of each of the disability categories, specifically autism, and be able to develop effective instructional plans for students
- Align general education curriculum and special education in providing high quality, standards-based instruction/intervention that is matched to students' academic, social, emotional, and behavioral needs
- Ability to identify student challenges, design interventions, and monitor the effectiveness of appropriate interventions
- Knowledge and experience with current technology to implement in classroom instruction
- Understand and use data about student learning, adapt and modify instruction, use technology appropriately, and adapt curriculum successfully
- Identify barriers to accessibility and acceptance of individuals with disabilities as well as potential strategies and skills necessary to overcome potential barriers.
- Prepare and maintain compliant student reports (Re-evaluation Report, IEP, FBA, BID, Progress Monitoring) as required by state laws and district policies
- Demonstrate an understanding of and apply FERPA (Family Education Right to Privacy Act), requiring confidentiality in all educational interactions with students, families, and non-educational agency personnel
- Promote positive relationships to support collaboration and partnerships with all team members, including family members, to plan for and educate the student in a way that will maximize his/her educational experience
- Employ special educational strategies and techniques during instruction to improve the development of sensory and perceptual-motor skills, language, cognition, and memory
